Preparing for the Year of the Monkey



Clean your entry to welcome all the good luck that will come into your home and place of business in the New Year. Wash, sweep, or vacuum the front steps, porch, entry hall, and lobby. Make this area clean, well lit, and inviting. Check the entry's lighting fixtures, make sure the doorbell works, and touch up scuff marks with a fresh coat of paint, or add a new rug to welcome the New Year.

- 2) Add beautiful flowers to welcome the New Year! It's fortunate to add plants, flowers, and healthy bamboo to your home and workplace to increase abundance. Fresh flowers bring fresh aroma that clears the air for New Year. The energy of a room is brightened by the addition of flowers and plants. And plants offer fresh oxygen to improve health. Lucky flowers are orchids, peonies, and lilies. Avoid thorny plants like a cactus, indoors or outdoors. Instead, grow lush plants that have soft round leaves like a jade plant or philodendron. Silk flowers are superb in Feng Shui because they are a wonderful way to add light and life to your environment. If you bring home a lovely orchid, after the flower wilts, cut away the dead stalk and insert a good-quality silk orchid into your container. Then your orchid seems to be always in bloom, instead of a dead stalk tied to a stake. Keep watering it and watch it bloom again.
- 3) This is a perfect time for Feng Shui to help you imbue the energizing spirit of the Monkey. The Bagua focus to create abundance for Fire Monkey year is the Fame/Reputation area. This is located in the far back wall from the entry. The more fame and recognition that Monkeys receive for their wild schemes and innovative concepts, the more inspired they are to accomplish and create. The second area for focus in Monkey year is the Career area, located opposite the Fame/Reputation area. Monkeys apply more of their ingenious wit and dynamic energy to a career that they find personally satisfying. By enhancing both of these areas with the following sample enhancements, your prosperity and creative energy will begin to flow.

The Bagua

The Feng Shui Bagua (Ba-gua) Map, is represented as a grid of nine sectors. The Bagua comes from the Chinese philosophy, "The I Ching," and literally means "eight trigrams", with the center being for centering and grounding.



ENTRANCE QUADRANT

Fame Area (Fire Element)

- * Photos or art representing achievements, inspiration, stars, suns, people, animals representing upward movement
- * Items in the colors red
- * Items representing the fire element with candles and lighting

Career Area (Water Element)

- * Items in items in black or very dark colors, glass/crystal items
- * Water features, (fountains, waterfalls or aquariums)
- * Art depicting water scenes and/or representations of your current or intended career

When using the Bagua map, be sure that all areas are clean with no clutter. Avoiding clutter in the Monkey year will avert feelings of being overwhelmed or confused. Keep a clear path to your aspirations. Make sure that the first thing seen in each room is beautiful and inspiring. You do not want to see a pile of paperwork or any type of mess.

Affirmations:

Remember that in Feng Shui, intent plays a significant role in enhancing any area of your home or business. That's why all enhancements need to be made with intentionality; written or stated affirmations are very important. It is also important for them to be expressed as if they have already happened. Examples while you're in the year of the Monkey: "My book is being published," "I just received a check advance for my creative idea," "I bought tickets for my around the world cruise."
